9.00am—The famous **Laggan Markets** run on the 3rd Saturday of each month and enjoying a warm welcome from the locals is a great way to start your retail therapy!

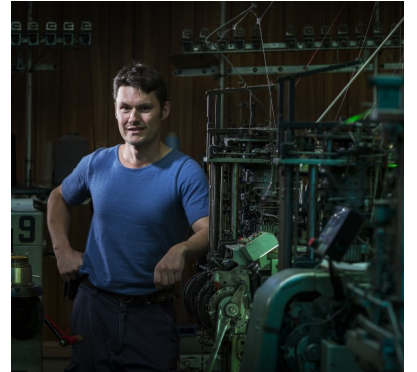

1.00pm—Time for lunch at **Café Zest** in the heart of Crookwell, a town renowned for its potatoes, fine wool and prime lambs and for being the largest town in the region.

In Gunning, standouts include Creative Gunning, the Picturehouse Gallery and Bookshop, and Will&Russ, with its focus on foraged goods.
